Cherubini's Les Abencérages, premiered in 1813, heralds the spectacle and extravagance of Romantic grand opera. From the Alhambra gardens to the battlefield, the action skilfully intertwines political conspiracies with a love story. Underpinned by the energy and timbres of period instruments, this recording demonstrates the work's modernity and its musical qualities. Anaïs Constans valiantly tackles the demanding role of Noraïme, while Edgaras Montvidas displays his lyric tenor voice in a series of sublime airs whose beauty was already hinted at by none other than Roberto Alagna in a recital disc released in 2003. Around this couple, a plethoric cast of soloists achieves the same high standards of French diction and style. The Hungarian conductor György Vashegyi, flanked by the Purcell Choir and Orfeo Orchestra, reveals here another key milestone of French Romantic opera.

Italiano, ma non troppo...

The importance of foreign composers in the construction of the national genre of French opera has often been remarked upon — and rightly so. Cherubini represents a special case in this context. Though trained in the Italian manner, he formed a link between the Vienna of Mozart and Beethoven and the Paris of Méhul and Grétry rather than with the composers of his native land. It was in this context of experimentation that Cherubini was assigned Étienne de Jouy's libretto for Les Abencérages. Through its subtle political references, the opera displays the exoticism of the settings, the picturesque nature of the social traditions and the violence of religious obligations. To amplify the tragic destinies of its truly Romantic heroine, the librettist uses all the key elements of the mélodrame that the Parisian audience loved. The composer, very much in tune with his time, seized upon the best of his contemporaries' inspirations and made them his own. On the occasion of this recording, the Palazzetto Bru Zane has edited and published for the first time the complete set of performing materials (full and vocal scores, orchestral parts), which had remained in manuscript form until now.


